

“CAT TRACKS SCARF”

Designed for ALPINE MEADOW ARTISAN YARNS™ by Robley Brown



This scarf is knit in garter stitch, even the lace trim, and will make a nice snugly addition to your wardrobe. **Finished size:** 5 ½ " x 53".

REQUIRES:

Yarn: 2 Skeins Alpine Meadow “Moonbeams” Sport Weight Yarn (approx. 240 yards)

Needles: U.S. Size 10 1/2, Darning Needle to weave in ends

Pictured in: “Moonbeams” Winter Wonderland

ABBREVIATIONS:

YO: Yarn over. Wrap yarn over the needle from front to back of work.

K2tog: Knit two stitches together as if they were one.

Begin Scarf:

Cast on 26 stitches

BORDER: Work rows 1 – 10 →See chart on pg. 3

PATTERN: Work rows 11-31 once →See chart on pg. 3

CENTER: Knit across all rows until scarf measures 48”

PATTERN: Work rows 11-31 once →See chart on pg. 3

BORDER: Work rows 10 through 1 →See chart on pg. 3

Cast off.

Finishing: Weave in ends. Wash gently in cool water, rinse, blot on towel. Lay flat on towel and pat into shape. Let dry. Wear and Enjoy!
